Learning Goals for Media Literacy

Produce and edit a photograph in Adobe Photoshop that depicts movement. Collaborate with peers so you can explain the strategies and techniques used to edit and create your image.

Success Criteria

1. I can take a photograph on a device and upload it to shared drive and import that photograph into Adobe Photoshop
2. I can clearly explain why I altered the values of my image and how I created the illusion of movement
3. I can explain how my collaboration skills helped me produce this media text

Practice 2 periods

-Two periods of discovering. Students will begin if they have signed the Flipped Classroom form

1. Upload an image
2. Play with tool bars
3. Play with effects
4. Play with values

Creating your Photograph Chalk art - 1 Class

1. Get images off various devices
2. Put copy of original photograph in Portfolio
3. Convert to black/white (Tint Black and White using effects)
4. Edit image to create illusion of movement
5. Put completed image beside original in portfolio
6. Place reflection in portfolio Optional (Discussion needed)
